

# Entrepreneurial Freedom in a Southern Town Called Liberty

**Clay Herron and Abe Muniz of Twin Oaks Landscape Management in Liberty, South Carolina, have each been in the landscaping business for 20-plus years.** They've worked together for six of them. To say they're on the same page is an understatement.

"The biggest thing is we're both family men," Clay says. "We work five days a week, and that's all we'll take on. We're home every afternoon to take care of our kids and our families."

"We work as much as we need, not as much as we want," Abe adds. "You can always work more, but you can never get more time. Time is good."

Time is also a good thing to save on the jobsite, especially when attention to detail is what separates your company from the competition. Inefficiency gets in the way of quality, and that gets in the way of achieving the proper work/life balance.

"I love what I do," Abe relates. "When you love it, you can see what needs to be done when you're on a property. Our goal is never to blow through as fast as possible. Good work takes time."

The Walker Mower has played a big role in helping Clay and Abe save time, which has afforded them the ability to spend more time on the finer details of maintaining a property. Whether they're collecting grass, mulching grass, or vacuuming up leaves or shrub clippings, the duo agrees that providing five-star service on a 9-5 schedule could never happen without their two Walkers.

## Two Landscaping Paths Lead to Liberty

Clay Herron's landscaping career started more than two decades ago when he lived in Alabama. After graduating from college, he initially took a job with a construction company. He didn't really enjoy it, though, and ended up joining a landscape maintenance company. He worked there for about three years.

"I really enjoyed the variety that came with landscape maintenance through the different seasons," Clay says. "I liked cutting grass in the summer and cleaning up leaves in the fall. I also liked the little break we got in the wintertime before starting all over again the next spring."

Clay must have really liked it, because he started a landscape maintenance company of his own when he moved back home to South Carolina in 2003. He reached out to a homebuilding contractor he'd worked for in high school. Clay worked for that contractor for seven months while mowing lawns and building up a

customer base at night. Then the day came when he felt comfortable making lawn maintenance his full-time job.

Like Clay, Abe Muniz's landscaping roots extend many miles beyond Liberty, South Carolina. Abe's father was a landscaper in California. "I used to help him out on jobs as a kid," Abe tells. "I started landscaping as an actual occupation when I was 20. I had my hands on both the installation and maintenance sides. Then I moved to South Carolina around 2013 and got a job with a landscape installation company there."

That company is where Clay and Abe first met. The company decided to start a maintenance division, and merging with Clay's company seemed like a logical way to do that. So they merged. Abe ended up running one of the maintenance crews.

In less than two years, however, the recently merged companies decided on an amicable divorce. The goal had

of area landscaping companies, but getting a fresh start with Clay sounded very appealing.

"What it really came down to was the accounts I brought with me," Abe points out. "Those accounts were a lot of my hard work. I'd put my heart and soul into those properties, and I hated to see them just go away. Clay told me his plan. If he kept his accounts and I kept some of mine, we could make it work."

Clay and Abe recall a rather smooth transition. Their customers were already familiar with them and the type of service they delivered. Today, Twin Oaks Landscape Management has around 45 accounts, mostly higher-end residential properties of varying size and scope. Customer turnover is almost nil, which is just the way Clay and Abe like it.

"Our route is full, and we have to say 'no' a lot more often than we say 'yes' when new inquiries come in," Clay points out. There isn't a shred of arrogance in that statement, either.

been to rapidly grow the maintenance division by playing off of the natural synergies with a construction division. But staffing difficulty on the maintenance side proved to be an insurmountable challenge.

"Fortunately, I had structured the merger so I could keep my equipment and accounts without any interference," Clay says. "Abe and I had both recognized the writing on the wall. So he and I spoke. I told him how much I loved the work he did, and that I would love to have him come on with me. And that was it."

With all of the experience Abe had, he could have found a job with a lot

## Two Guys with Two Walkers

Clay Herron first used a Walker Mower 20-plus years ago when working for the landscape company in Alabama.

"I didn't use it a whole lot, but the quality of cut really enticed me to want to produce that same quality of work if I ever started my own company," Clay says. "I didn't have a Walker when I first started my own company in 2003, simply because I

couldn't afford it. About four years into it, I bought a used Walker. Now I usually put about 1,000 hours on a new machine and trade it in. Once you've used a Walker, there is just no going back."

Clay has long been an avid fan of the Model T for its collection and striping capabilities. Within the past couple of years, he has also begun using a Model B with a 48-inch mulching deck. "The B is becoming my primary mower now," Clay says. "It has saved us a lot of time and effort on some of our accounts where we have no way to dispose of the clippings."

In addition to mulching and striping well, Abe likes the Model B's ability to handle slopes. He also spends quite a bit of time on their Model T. He has come to appreciate the maneuverability and ease of operation of both machines. That wasn't necessarily the case in the beginning.

Abe first used a Walker Mower prior to joining forces with Clay.

"I remember my first day with that other company in South Carolina," Abe says. "I came to this property we're on today and learned how to use a Walker. I had run zero-turns before, but the Walker was all new to me and took a little while to get used to. Let's just say the lines didn't look like they do today."

Abe got the hang of things quickly, though, and operating a Walker has become second nature. It's also second nature to Clay, as is the concept of providing a seamless landscape management experience for customers. Clay's philosophy is to focus on what he and Abe do best, and partner with other contractors who are the best in other areas.

"I joke that I've got a guy for everything," Clay says. "I have a

tree guy, an irrigation guy, and an installation guy. That appeals to some clients, while others don't like it. But as a whole, our clients appreciate what we do and don't get upset at having to use other contractors. They know those other contractors are people we trust and will do a good job. Plus, we take care of scheduling everything to make their lives easier."

Making a person's life easier is something both Clay and Abe appreciate. Striking that proper work/life balance is something they've emphasized from the first day they broke out on their own. They've never worried about being the biggest landscape maintenance contractor, just the best in the eyes of their customers.

"My motto has always been 'small by design,'" Clay relates. "We do as much as we can do and focus on quality. If we ever do lose a client, the phone always seems to ring."

If a call comes in after hours, though, Clay might let it go to voicemail until the next morning. After all, afternoons and weekends are family time.

# Walker Advantages

## Front-Mount Deck

Achieving a beautiful cut has been our focus from the very first Walker Mower design. Positioning the mowing deck in front of the machine is fundamental to producing high-quality results. The front-mount deck of the Walker reduces impact on the turf prior to cutting, resulting in a more consistent, carpet-like finish. This result is achieved by transferring weight from the deck caster tires which minimizes matting of the grass.



The Walker's flexible deck suspension provides smooth, consistent cutting as the front mounted deck articulates independently of the tractor following ground contour, minimizing scalping, and providing a beautiful cut.

The Walker torsion-flex carrier frame allows the deck to freely articulate and flex laterally, producing a smooth cut, even over complicated ground contours. This makes Walker Mowers ideal for mowing uneven turf.

## Short Deck Coupling

Front-mount decks also create a shorter distance between the contact point of the drive tire and the contact point of the front caster tire, allowing Walker decks to precisely follow ground contours. Compared to mid-mount hanging decks used on other mowers, Walker mowing decks scalp less and leave less uncut grass in the valleys of ground contours.




Each Walker features a tilt-open body, quickly exposing the drive belts, electrical system, engine, and drivetrain, making service and maintenance easy. No special tools or equipment are needed. Simply release the body latch, and the gas spring assisted enclosure opens up for unobstructed access to all of the Walker's working components.

All Walker decks quickly tilt up, making maintenance tasks safe and easy. It takes seconds to unlock, lift, and secure the deck in an up position, providing access to the blades, housing, and chute. 
## Grass Handling System® (GHS)

Walker invented the internal Grass Handling System® on its first mower, and it remains the most efficient way to vacuum grass clippings, leaves, and debris from the lawn.

Collection decks move clippings to a center, rear discharge chute where an internal blower vacuums grass clippings and debris, and then blows it directly into a compact, rear-mounted grass catcher box. The PowerFil® oscillating chute evenly packs clippings, and the Grass-Pak® full signal alerts the operator when it is time to empty the catcher. To dump clippings, the operator simply lifts the catcher with the side handles, or utilizes the optional Power Dump or Hi-Dump® add-ons from the operator seat.





There are no bulky tubes or bags extending beyond the footprint of the mower. By positioning the GHS blower internally, a powerful vacuum action is achieved, leaving a carpet-like appearance to your lawn in spring, summer, and fall.







# Growth Mode in the Montreal Suburbs

**For a guy who wasn't even sure he wanted to be in the lawn maintenance business, Cedric Soucy is doing pretty well for himself.** He made his part-time mowing business official in 2012 after finishing college. He had three employees at that time. In 2020 he was up to 10. Just a few years later, that number has doubled to 20.

Cedric attributes the recent growth of his company, Pelouses et Entretien Soucy in Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville, Quebec, Canada, to a couple things. First, he made a stronger commitment to his business, compared to his younger years when he was pursuing his bachelor's degree. Second, he has invested in good equipment that has made his crews more productive, allowing him to take on much larger properties.

The commitment of Cedric and his team has been key, because the growth hasn't just fallen into their laps.

"We had some really tough moments over the years," Cedric relates. "There were times when I didn't even know if I wanted to continue. Everything around the business—financials, weather, employees—was not always easy. But we worked a lot, and I'm proud to say that we got through it. And once I switched my mind to going pedal to the metal, we grew fast."

"With the quantity of clients we now have, I could never do this on my own," Cedric adds. "Everyone on our team is important. I might not even be here today if not for the great team we've had for the past few years. It's very motivating when you see people actually want to work with you. And I always say, we are here to work, but let's have fun, too."

### **Bigger Requires Better**

Cedric Soucy first started mowing lawns at age 11, pushing a walk mower around his neighborhood. By primary school he had around 10 customers. His first "big" machine was a 32-inch walk-behind mower. Then he got a riding mower with a slightly larger deck. Cedric continued mowing lawns and adding customers during his four years at university. He had planned for his lawn mowing days to come to an end once he graduated. But as graduation was approaching, he was having second thoughts.

"When I finished getting my business degree in 2012, I couldn't see myself working for a big company in an office all day," Cedric says. "We had developed some good relationships with customers and suppliers, and I wondered how far we could go if we want all in. So I officially started Pelouses et Entretien Soucy (Soucy Lawns & Maintenance) in 2012."

Settling on a name for his "official" company was Cedric's first tough decision. He was just going to call it Pelouses Soucy (Soucy Lawns), but decided to add the et Entretien (and maintenance) after thinking about where he wanted his company to go. He envisioned servicing larger

properties and providing more services one day. Sure enough, after a few years, certain clients began asking for things like bed maintenance, hedge trimming, fertilizing and leaf cleanup. With all of the trees in the Montreal suburbs, fall leaf cleanup is big business. Cedric has also gotten into services like aerating and topdressing, two important steps to building healthy lawns in an area where lawn pesticides are strictly regulated.

"Once we started doing more work and more types of work, we started getting more inquiries from new clients," Cedric says. More importantly, it was the right type of clients. Cedric wanted to maintain a solid base of

higher-end residential customers, but also wanted to add more commercial sites and condominiums. Doing so would allow him to build his company around a nucleus of great people and equipment.

"The more small lawns we have that require small mowers, the more

employees we need," Cedric says, while adding that he has a great team in place, but finding new employees is getting harder every year. "We decided a few years ago that we wanted to develop our business around the Walker Mower and bigger sites. We also invested in some bigger blowers and trailers to help with leaf cleanup. We also bought an innovative machine that allows us to apply topdressing and grass seed at the same time. Getting the right equipment has been a huge help."

As for his Walker fleet, Cedric owns three Model T27i's with 42-inch collection decks. He has also invested in a 42-inch mulching deck, along with a 56-inch side-discharge deck for mowing larger, more wide-open properties that don't have so many trees. On the other hand, the 42-inch deck is essential on most properties because it allows Cedric's employees to maneuver around trees, flower beds and other landscape features.

"We bought our first Walker Mower just four years ago," Cedric says. "I didn't know anything about the brand at first; I'd just seen another contractor in another city who was using this yellow machine with a gray box behind it. I talked to him about the mower and

who the dealer was. I visited the dealer, Fauteux Mini-Moteur, and talked with the manager. At first I thought it sounded a bit expensive for a lawn mower. But the next year, we were having some issues with the mowers we had. I decided it was time to step up and try a Walker. It was a game-changer right away."

To Cedric, the main benefit of the Walker is its efficiency. His clients don't see as much value in a beautifully striped lawn. Rather, they want their lawns to look clean. That is where the Walker has made a big difference. Whether it's collecting grass clippings or vacuuming up the thousands of leaves and helicopters that fall from trees throughout the year, the Walker Mower has given Cedric an efficient way to improve not only customer

"We used to advertise a lot," Cedric says. "Aside from a few social media postings, we don't do much advertising anymore. We are getting more applications than ever, though. I think it's because we have invested a lot in our brand. We have created a new logo and put it on our trucks, shirts and hats. People see our nice trucks and equipment. They hear from others about what it's like to work here. I think that has helped a lot."

Seeing crews on prestigious properties has also helped strengthen the company's image. As Cedric

Pelouses et Entretien Soucy is feeling pretty fine right now. The company has survived its first 10 years in business, which included an unprecedented pandemic. It has been pedal to the metal ever since. Now Cedric says they have the right tools to pursue the growth of his business and remain open to new opportunities.

"When you first start a business, it's hard to just focus on your ideal persona," Cedric says. "When you're trying to build a company, you have to do a lot of different work. That's

satisfaction, but also his company's productivity and profitability.

"From spring through fall, I can't even see myself without a Walker Mower now," Cedric says.

### **Building a Business by Building Relationships**

Cedric Soucy says he can't see himself without his great employees, either. An excellent core team is supplemented by college students who typically work three or four seasons before graduating and starting their careers. Recruiting new employees has become easier as the company has become more well-known.

mentioned earlier, having the right equipment has been critical to taking on larger commercial accounts. Building relationships has been critical to keeping those accounts.

"I always tell a new client that we strive to develop long-term relationships," Cedric says. "The communication between us and our employees needs to be clear and easy."

For instance, Cedric encourages clients to voice any concerns right away. "Sometimes it's a very small detail," Cedric points out. "But to the client, it's very important. If we know it, we can fix it, and then we're fine for the rest of the season."

how you build word of mouth and increase sales. But you never forget about your ideal persona. Once you build up to a certain level, then you can start to focus on what you really want to do and the types of clients you want to serve. It took a while, but we've been at that level for the past couple of years. I'm proud of where the company is today."







# Alabama First Responder Takes Second Crack at a Lawn Mowing Business



Curt Butler has been in the fire service for more than 20 years. He has served full-time with the city of Decatur, AL since 2004. He is currently a lieutenant.

**Curt Butler has been in the firefighting service since he was old enough to drive a car.** He began as a volunteer at age 16 and has been full-time since 2004. Throughout his entire career, lawn maintenance is something Curt has also enjoyed and almost always done on the side. Now, with a houseful of kids and retirement from the fire service on the horizon, Curt has begun laying the groundwork for a lawn maintenance business of his own.

Curt and his wife, Kelly, officially started Priceville Lawncare in Priceville, Alabama, in January 2023. The couple had been thinking about starting their own business for a while. Given Curt's background and connections, lawn maintenance seemed to be a natural choice.

Like a lot of lawn maintenance professionals, Curt started mowing lawns as a young teenager, mainly for family and

friends. "My first customer was my aunt," Curt fondly recalls. After graduating high school, lawn care was set aside as Curt continued as a volunteer firefighter while working full-time at a machine shop. He did that for eight years before he and a firefighting friend got an idea.

"Some friends of ours from neighboring fire departments started a lawn maintenance business and were doing really well," Curt says. "My buddy and I thought we'd try starting a business of our own." Curt and his friend purchased a mid-mount zero-turn and quickly built up a client base of roughly a dozen properties. Things were going well, but Curt wasn't completely content. Those firefighter friends with the other lawn business were running Walker Mowers. That's what Curt wanted, too. He wouldn't have to wait long to get one.

"One day I'd stopped into the local small engine shop for



some parts," Curt tells. "While I was waiting at the counter, one of the owners set this flyer in front of me and said, 'Soon I'll be able to sell you one of these mowers.' It was a flyer for Walker and they had just become a dealer. Next thing you know, I had a 20-hp, 48-inch Model T with the grass-handling system. That was 20 some odd years ago."

### Always at Your Service

Curt and his buddy continued doing well and were loving their new Walker Mower. But the demands of mowing every night and on Saturdays while holding down full-time jobs was beginning to take a toll. After a couple of years, they decided to sell their business. Curt couldn't shake his itch to mow lawns, though. Before long he was back in the seat of a Walker Mower. Only this time, he was working for the lawn company that originally inspired him to become a Walker user in the first place.

That phase of Curt Butler's lawn mowing odyssey lasted for a couple of years before Curt came to another fork in the road. In 2004 at the age of 26, Curt was offered a full-time firefighting job in nearby Decatur, Alabama. He took it, and his lawn mowing days came to an end once again. But once again, the hiatus would only last so long.

Now a full-time firefighter working 24 hours on and 48 hours off, Curt initially took a liking to having some time off. But within a couple of years, Curt and Kelly welcomed their first child, daughter Ava, in 2006. Curt remembered how nice that extra money was when he used to mow lawns. A little extra money would come in handy now that he and Kelly were building their family.

Curt got a part-time job with a local landscaping company. He didn't mow lawns, though. He was primarily tasked with laying sod and helping

install irrigation systems. When the housing market crashed in 2008, that type of work all but vanished. Curt pivoted to what he truly enjoyed anyway, which was mowing lawns. He got a job with another local contractor, a well-respected commercial maintenance company.

"The owner of that company, Gerald Crafts, became the closest thing to a mentor I've ever had," Curt says. Gerald taught Curt not only about running a business, but also how to carry oneself professionally with a desire to help others.

Curt used his off days from the fire

department to work for Gerald. He did that for several years while he and Kelly were growing their family. They adopted two siblings, Bella and Daniel. Three years ago they adopted their fourth child, Beau.

"Our kids are a big part of our story, along with where our story is heading," Curt says. His desire to serve others is what drove him back into landscaping in 2006. Now, in 2023 and six years from retiring from the fire service, serving others and providing for his family are what's driving Curt toward starting his own lawn maintenance company for the second time.



## The Next Chapter After Firefighting

"Kelly and I had often talked about starting our own business," Curt says. "In the fall of 2022, we decided it was time, and there was no doubt we had to have a Walker."

Curt and Kelly started doing some research. They found a used Model R for sale on Facebook Marketplace from a private owner in Georgia. "Used" isn't the right word to describe this mower; it only had 5-1/2 hours on it. The owner had bought a new

house with a much smaller yard, and didn't need a riding mower anymore. Curt was able to purchase it for a bargain price.

"I really like the Model R with the 42-inch deck because it will go through all of the gates in the neighborhoods I mow," Curt says. "There is no need to also have a 36-inch stand-on mower or a small push mower. My Model R came with side discharge, and the previous owner also had the optional bagging system and counterweight.



But the bagging system wouldn't be beneficial for me because of the gates I need to get through. I also didn't want to be discharging grass in certain yards; you take a chance with rocks and can also throw grass into flower beds. So I decided the best thing to do was add the mulch kit."

After consulting with the Walker factory and enlisting the help of his closest Walker Dealer, Hill Lawnmower & Chainsaw in Huntsville, Alabama, Curt had his mulch kit properly installed. He was off and running with his new lawn business by February

2023. That's also when Curt happened upon an opportunity to buy a second used Walker, this time a Model T which he had seen on a Facebook group for Walker Mower users.

The Model T with a 48-inch deck had been traded in by a landscape contractor. The machine had around 500 hours on it. The seller was a dealer in Missouri, quite a long drive for Curt to go pick it up. After working out some arrangements, Curt made the two-hour drive north to Nashville, Tennessee, to meet the dealer who was attending a tradeshow. "I picked this mower up at 10 p.m. in the parking lot of a Hampton Inn," Curt says with a grin.

Whether he's mulching with his Model R or collecting with his Model T, Curt says he appreciates the versatility of his Walker Mowers. He really values the tilt-up deck.

"Having the ability to flip the deck up to swap out blades is a game changer, especially for a small business like mine," Curt says. "I don't have a shop with lifts and jacks and huge power tools. Everything has to be done

in a driveway or in the back of my enclosed trailer."

For serious maintenance and repair issues, Curt says he values the service he gets from his Walker Dealer, Bryan Hill of Hill Lawnmower & Chainsaw. As Curt looks to grow his business over the next several years, he has two goals. First, he doesn't want to get so big that the business becomes difficult to control. Second, he wants to grow enough that there is a need and ability to purchase new mowers. "When that happens, Bryan will be my first phone call," Curt says. "Who knows, maybe one day you'll call me up and we can talk about my fleet of Walker Mowers."

For now, Curt Butler is going to focus on what he has been doing for the better part of the past two decades: fighting fires and mowing lawns. He currently has around 15 lawn customers. By staying true to the principles that have enabled so much success to this point, he is confident that his business goals will ultimately be achieved.

"The biggest thing is customer service," Curt relates. "In both the fire service and in lawn care, if your customer isn't satisfied, you have problems. Whether your home is on fire or you simply need your lawn mowed, it's my job to assure the customer that I will be there, and that everything will be OK."

# Coming Full Circle in Lancaster County

**Throughout his first two years in business, Tyler Deiter resisted the idea of mowing lawns.** “I’d always told myself I was going to become a landscaper, not a landscaper,” Tyler says with a grin. Now 10-plus years later, mowing has become a profitable and enjoyable part of Tyler’s business.

The key to making lawn maintenance a successful add-on service has come down to one word: selective. Beautiful Estates Landscaping only offers mowing to select communities within the greater Lancaster County area. This allows Tyler to optimize his routing, which enables him to consolidate mowing to Thursdays and Fridays.

Tyler has also become pretty particular about his mowing methods. He tells customers he will maintain their lawns to a healthy height of 3 to 3-1/2 inches, and will recycle clippings back into the yard as much as possible. Tyler also promotes the fact that his mowers are compact and lightweight, and feature a floating deck that won’t scalp the lawn. Remember, Tyler wanted nothing to do with mowing if it meant he’d become a landscaper.

It took a little while to get where he is today, but Tyler Deiter is a far cry from a landscaper. He has a couple of customers to thank for that.

“One of my landscaping customers who owned a dentist’s office kept insisting that we mow her property,” Tyler says. “One day she came out and handed me a contract. She said if we could match the price, it was ours. So I went and bought a mower and started mowing.”

Tyler’s first mower was a residential-grade zero-turn. It got the job done, but pushed him right to the edge of becoming a dreaded landscaper. A year or so later, Tyler caught a glimpse of a unique kind of mower.

“A customer we were doing flower bed maintenance for had their own Walker Mower,” Tyler says. The mower really piqued Tyler’s curiosity. “The customer said I could use it to pick up leaves when we started doing fall cleanups,” Tyler continues. “I really enjoyed the controls and not having to use a big side chute for a bagger.”



It took a couple years of prodding, but existing landscaping customers finally convinced Tyler to start mowing.

After a couple seasons of running his customer's Walker, Tyler started thinking about getting his own. Then, in the summer of 2018, getting his own became a necessity. It was the wettest summer on record, and Tyler would be unable to mow for a couple of weeks in August.

"The grass was still growing like crazy when my fiancé, Jennifer, and I were about to get married," Tyler recalls. "We knew our yards would be hayfields after being away for our honeymoon. I went to the local Walker Dealer and bought a used Model T so I could do a good job of bagging. It got us through that wet summer, and our customers really liked the way their lawns looked."

Aside from the fact that there weren't piles of grass clippings lying all over the lawn, Tyler says customers also noticed that the cut was more even, and there weren't any scalps or ruts. When customers began telling Tyler they wanted him to use his new mower all of the time, he figured he better take a step up. So he sold that first used machine and bought a new Model T with the Power Dump option. He then purchased a new Model B a year or so later. Each of Tyler's Walkers is used strategically throughout the year, leveraging multiple 48-inch decks that

enable him to collect, mulch or side-discharge as conditions warrant.

### **Grandpa Brings Out a Green Thumb**

Tyler Deiter started developing his green thumb at an early age. "I was home-schooled, and couldn't wait to get outside to work in the garden after school," he relates.

Tyler inherited his interest in plants from his grandfather who was in the greenhouse business. When Tyler was 12, his grandpa tore his rotator cuff. He looked to Tyler for some assistance. "He would pick me up in his little pickup truck and take me along to planting jobs," Tyler says.

Many of those planting customers saw how much pride Tyler took in working with his grandpa. Some began asking Tyler to perform other landscaping chores while he was on their property. Within a few years, Tyler had a nice little business going.

"I got my first truck, when I was 16," Tyler says. Then, when he turned 18, he decided to make it official and give his landscaping business a name. After conferring with his father, Beautiful Estates Landscaping was born.

As pointed out earlier, Tyler didn't mow lawns at first. But over the past few years, mowing has become an essential part of the business. Tyler's customers include numerous 1/4 to 3/4-acre residential lawns, along with a few smaller commercial properties. Tyler has also begun subcontracting for another area landscape contractor, spending roughly one day a week mowing an apartment complex.

Throughout the spring, Tyler primarily uses his Model T so he can collect the clippings. He'll also use his Model B to side-discharge areas of a property that are more wide open. During the summer when lawns start drying out, Tyler begins using his Model B almost exclusively with a mulching deck. In the fall, he'll switch back to the Model T with a mulching deck to chop up leaves. "If the leaves are really thick with a lot of moisture, we'll often go over the lawn a second time and vacuum up the excess," Tyler points out.

Since mowing is consolidated to Thursdays and Fridays, Tyler spends the first half of the week mulching, replacing bushes and small trees, planting flowers, maintaining beds, pruning, hedge trimming and light hardscaping. He also subcontracts for another friendly competitor during the winter. He uses that contractor's Walker Mower with a snowblower attachment to keep the sidewalks clear at a medical facility.

Whatever the season, Tyler spends most of his time in the field, working. He also takes care of all the scheduling. But aside from that, his wife, Jennifer, is in charge of other business-related

functions. It's a good thing, too.

"I'm not good at the business stuff at all," Tyler concedes. Jennifer used to work at an ag supply company and is very proficient at billing, accounting and other administrative tasks. "She also grew up on a dairy farm," Tyler is quick to add, "so she is more than willing to get out on jobsites to help push wheelbarrows around and do other work."

As his business has grown, Tyler has needed Jennifer's help on more than one occasion. He has also been able to count on assistance from a few other family members.

## A Dozen Siblings Provide a Steady Supply of Labor

Tyler Deiter is the oldest of 13. Many of his nine brothers and three sisters have worked with him at some point.

"I make a great first job," Tyler says. It's not a family requirement to work for him, though. Truth be told, everyone enjoys getting outside just as much as Tyler always has. Just for safe measure, he has a little trick up his sleeve. "I always make sure to entice my siblings with plenty of slushies and soft drinks," Tyler says with a chuckle.

These days, Tyler is joined by five of his brothers. Grant and Kyle work full-time. Kent, Logan and Connor help out as needed. Tyler says he enjoys having a variety of things to do; running his front-end loader one day, pruning the next, and mowing the day after that. As for his siblings, Tyler tries to steer them in the direction of their natural abilities.

"Most of my siblings are hands-on learners," Tyler says. "It's neat to see how each person's God-given talents play out. Kyle, for instance, is really good at running bigger equipment like our tractor and trucks. Grant enjoys the Walkers. Others are better at trimming and edging. Once I can see what their talents are and what they enjoy, I cater their jobs to those tasks."

"I don't think I want to grow anymore or hire additional people," Tyler continues. "I think that would come with a lot of headaches, and I'd like to keep it to just family. Seven years separate my youngest brother and my oldest son. So as long as I can retain my youngest brother long enough to fill that gap, I should be OK for many years to come."

With a casual eye on the future, Tyler Deiter can't help but reflect on the past from time to time, as well. He vividly

remembers all of those mornings when his grandfather picked him up to go plant flowers. When Tyler has a new landscaping project to complete, he calls his grandpa who still has the greenhouse business. "I tell him what I need and he gets it all ready for me to come pick up," Tyler tells.

# Add-ons: Implements

Implements mount interchangeably on most Walker models using the quick-change hitch system and require the use of the Implement Hitch. Tail weights may also be needed for counterbalancing.

A switch raises and lowers implements and is mounted on the Forward Speed Control lever for convenient operation.
